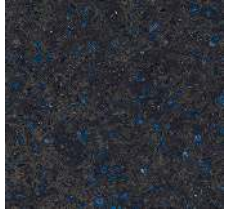

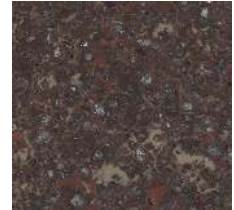

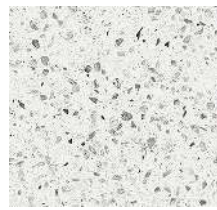

Disadvantages Of Quartz

- Higher price.
- Much heavier than glass.
- **Not** heat proof, chemical proof or fracture proof.

Recommendations For Care

- Clean periodically using a cloth dampened with warm water; use mild soap if desired.
- **Do not** expose quartz to bleach.
- **Do not** expose quartz to any type of chemical cleaner. (i.e.: Comet, Soft Scrub, etc.)
- Because quartz is not heat, chemical or fracture proof, be aware of exposure to these potential damaging elements to your quartz.
